Buses, Cafeteria

The cafeteria will be open for snacks between exam periods.

Finals:

- Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each period. If a student is tardy, he/she will not be given extra time for the exam. If a student is more than 15 minutes late, he/she will only be admitted to the exam with permission of an administrator.
- Seniors may qualify for exemption from a final exam. Seniors must have a 90% overall average or better in a full year class to qualify for exemption. Students who participate in the AP exam for a course are also eligible for this exemption at the teacher's discretion.
- Seniors are expected to remain in school on June 12th and 13th if they are required to take exams for their period 3, 4, 5, or 6 classes since exam reviews may be occurring in those classes.
- Students who do not have an exam may come in late or leave early if they arrange transportation. Students arriving late or leaving early must sign in and out of the main office. Students who arrive while an examination period is in progress must report directly to the cafeteria with a pass from the office.

Exam make-up policy:

- If a student is ill on the day of an exam, a parent must call the main office by 8 a.m. to report the absence.
- Students must obtain permission from an administrator before being granted an opportunity to make-up a final exam.
